

DIAGNOSTIC TESTING

An integral part of caring for your pet

When your pet is under the weather, they are relying on you to notice the signs. Look out for subtle changes that may indicate a hidden problem:



Endocrine

Obvious body weight change, increased appetite (yet no change in weight), vomit, excessive thirst, frequency of urination



Digestive

Vomit, diarrhoea, weight loss, body fluid loss



Heart and Lungs

Reduced endurance, coughs, dyspnoea, weight loss, bloated abdomen



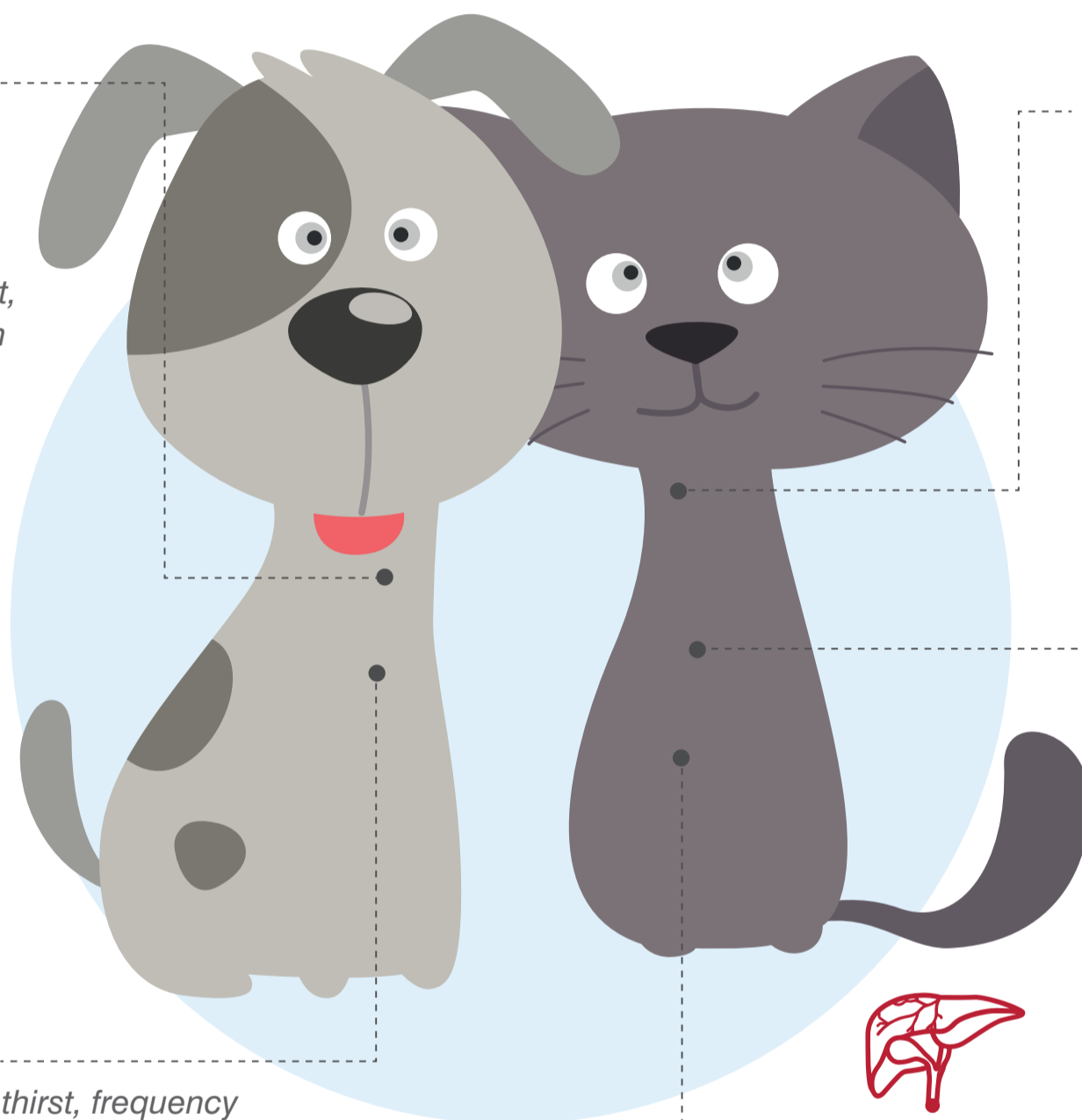
Kidney

Excessive thirst, frequency of urination, loss of appetite, weight loss, vomit, diarrhoea, back pain



Liver

Loss of appetite, weight loss, vomit, diarrhoea, excessive thirst, excessive urination



If you notice any of these symptoms in your dog or cat, diagnostic testing can support your vet in identifying the problem.
